Conductress carries a Candēlabra. Each Star Point officer places a candle of the color of her station after she has said her lines.

Adah,

Blue is the color of fidelity, loyalty and intelligence. If we wish to make our lives a shining star, we must first master the virtue of Adah, which is obedient loyalty.

Ruth,

Yellow is dedicated to Ruth and represents constancy, loyalty and friendship. Ruth's friendship with Naomi has become one of the world's greatest examples of the true meaning of real friendship. Only by being loyal to the best interests of our fellowman do we merit the giving or the gaining of a friendship.

Esther,

The white of billowing clouds and drifting snow is appropriate to Esther because her life and actions were free from blemish and she was above reproach in every way. We may emulate the ideals of purity and self-sacrifice by remaining faithful to our high standards and by conducting ourselves in every situation so that we remain above reproach.

Martha,

The deep color of springtime foliage is the symbol of renewed life and growth. We can strive to achieve the ideals of Faith, the Belief in Eternal Life, and in the Immortality of the Soul by studying the word of God and the life and teachings of Jesus Christ so that our ^{faith} may become as unshakable as the faith of Martha.

Electa,

Red was selected for Electa because it is the color of love and hospitality. True hospitality extends beyond supplying another with mere courtesies and physical comforts. We must regard every individual in terms of his worth and with regard for his advancement as a spiritual being. By consistently acting with love toward our fellow man, we may practise the high standards of Electa.

Conductress - (places candles on station of Worthy Matron)

The combination of the five star point colors is referred to as the Mystic Colors. A proper blending of the principles which these colors represent creates a power which may be used to bless and to benefit all of humanity.

Conductress - (lights candles)

I light these candles in recognition of the work you have done for our Beloved Order.
